The *Davy Crockett National Forest*, named for the legendary pioneer, contains more than 160,000 acres of East Texas woodlands, streams, recreation areas, and wildlife habitat. Located in Houston and Trinity Counties, the forest is centrally

located within the Neches and Trinity River basins. The *Davy Crockett National Forest* was proclaimed a National Forest by President Franklin Roosevelt on October 15, 1936. *Be sure and get you permission slip from Mr. Duffey!*

Battleship Texas State Historic Site - LaPorte, TX

In 1948, the Battleship *Texas* became the first battleship memorial museum in the U.S. That same year, on the anniversary of Texas Independence, the *Texas* was presented to the State of Texas and commissioned as the flagship of the Texas Navy. In 1983, the *Texas* was placed under the stewardship of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and is permanently anchored on the Buffalo Bayou and the busy Houston Ship Channel.

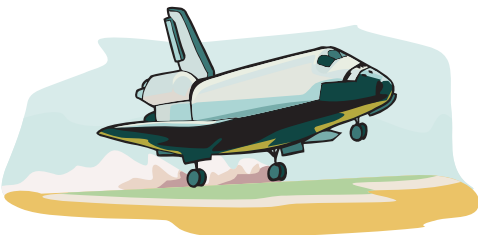
